

# **Our Story Today**

# 1 in 5 people in Miami's Jewish community depends on Federation

for some form of financial assistance or access to Jewish life — up 60 percent from just a few years ago.



Europe is facing the greatest humanitarian crisis since World War II, with many Ukrainians in the Jewish community fleeing for the safety and security of Israel. Already, 15,000 have made *aliyah* in 2022 and thousands more are expected in 2023.



To keep Jewish Miami safe amid rising extremism and antisemitism, Federation's Office of Community Security works with 160 essential Jewish institutions.



Federation is addressing food insecurity in the Jewish community **resulting from inflation and the economic fallout of the pandemic with Free Kosher Food Distribution Drive-Thrus in Miami**.



Federation is investing more than **\$2 million** yearly to support 10 Jewish day schools and **9 congregational schools**, serving 5,090 Miami students and ensuring a vibrant Jewish future.



### Who Is Federation Helping?

### Meet Lilyan

A single mother of two young boys, Lilyan was already struggling with high food prices when she lost her job at a local restaurant. After calling the Jewish community helpline, she was put in touch with Federation's primary human services agency, Jewish Community Services' Kosher Food Bank, where she was able to shop for nutritious kosher food each month and feed her growing children.

#### Meet Shifra

Shifra is a psychologist who lived in Kyiv, Ukraine. After a treacherous journey to Warsaw, Poland, where she was joined by members of her extended family, she was able to meet with The Jewish Agency for Israel, Federation's overseas partner, who arranged for their immigration and resettlement in Israel. Her children are adjusting well, but still she worries about the family she left behind.

#### Meet Abe

Abe is a Holocaust Survivor who enjoyed getting together regularly with friends for a game of bridge. When the pandemic forced Abe into isolation and he was unable to care for himself, depression took over. Then Federation's Jewish Volunteer Center reached out to Abe, providing a variety of services, including running errands and picking up medications for his diabetes. Abe is forever grateful for the care he received.

### Meet Michael

Growing up in an interfaith household, Michael was given little exposure to rituals and traditions. A friend invited him to join Birthright Israel, a free trip to Israel for young Jewish adults funded by Federation. Immersed in Israeli sights and experiences for 10 days, Michael felt a strong connection to the people and land of Israel, and made new friends, with whom he continues to socialize weekly at *Shabbat* dinners.











# What Are Federation's Key Priorities?

### Social Safety Net

Following the guiding principle that all Jews are responsible for one another, Federation supports programs and services that bring help and hope to people of all ages and at all stages of life. Federation feeds hungry families, offers programming and companionship for lonely seniors, provides counseling for children and families, supports people with disabilities, distributes loans and grants to those facing economic hardship and so much more. Together, we lift up the most vulnerable so they can live with independence and dignity.

### Education and Identity-Building Programs

While fostering connections to our history, heritage and traditions, Federation is ensuring a vibrant Jewish future. We help develop an enduring commitment to Jewish life and practice through **formal and informal education, funding PJ Library, Jewish day school and summer camp scholarships, Israel programs, Hillels on college campuses** and programs that enable young adults to bear witness to the devastation of the Holocaust and experience Israel for the first time. All of these create connections that last a lifetime.

### Building, Strengthening and Securing Community

Serving one of the most diverse populations in the nation, Federation is a unifying force for a caring Miami Jewish community. Our Jewish Community Relations Council fortifies our community in the face of antisemitism and the Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions (BDS) movement against Israel and builds bridges of understanding with diverse community partners. Our Office of Community Security works with schools, synagogues and institutions to keep our people safe throughout Miami-Dade County. Through volunteer opportunities, educational events and missions to Israel, we bring together people of all denominations, interests and backgrounds for a common purpose: the greater good of the Jewish people.
